

Data Formats and Procedures Working Group Meeting

Matera, Italy, casa cava, October 27, 2015, 13:00 h

- Problem with station epoch time scale 10 provided from Borowiec. This is not useful and it is suggested to use UTC(7) resp. GPS(4) time scale. Values of 10 and above are for time transfer experiments and if a station will use these values it has to be explained why and get the permission of CB.
- Dual path data delivery to both operation centers is not yet used by all stations. This is only for data reliability in case one center is offline.
 - New SLRMail to all stations on that will be send out
 - Stations not responding will be contacted regularly
- Leap second 2015. Situation was in general better than in 2012, but there were still critical aspects, though at least 4 reminders were sent out.
 - CPF predictions:
 - 8 providers ignored the ILRS regulations for leap second
 - 7 providers followed
 - 2 stopped prediction file before the leap second and started new file after the leap second. This procedure should be used for next leap second by all providers. WG will start actions in this direction.
 - No problems with the analysis centers.
 - Two network reported no problems
 - Data output was down significantly from July 1 – 3 2015, for what ever reason.
